H. S. Lombard was born in Otisfield, Maine, in 1835, was married to Rose A. Lowell in 1856. To this union were born two children, Fannie L. Foulk of Nelson, Nebraska, and Lillian F. Welch of Anthony, Kansas.

He went to Nebraska in 1869, where he resided until 1893 when he moved to Harper County, Kansas.

His wife departed this life January 24, 1911.

When a young man he united with the Congregational church and lived a true Christian.

Mr. Lombard was a pioneer settler and endured the hardships of homestead life in the early days.

He died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. A. C. Foulk, Nelson, Nebr., September 12, 1913.

The remains were brought to Anthony for interment. The uneral was held at the Baptist church Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 and was attended by old

neighbors and friends of the good man who had passed from a life of usefulness here to that larger and better life.
