FIRE. On Saturday night last, the house occupied as a tavern by Mr. Ebenezer Lumbard, in Tinmouth, and owned by Esq. Fish of Ira, was entirely consumed by fire. No articles of furniture were saved, excepting two beds. We learn that the fire is supposed to have taken from the oven, and was probably burning when the family retired to rest. They were not aroused till late at night, when the flames were bursting through the roof, and when they had barely time to rescue their half suffocated children from their apartments.
