

Mrs. A. Lombard Dies in Hospital

Elizabeth Lombard, 375 River Road, who came to Eugene in 1889, died Tuesday Morning in a Eugene hospital at the age of 81. Among her survivors are her husband, Atmer, retired contractor; a son, Clarence, Eugene banker, and another son, Herbert, Cottage Grove attorney.

Mrs. Lombard was born at Beardstown, Ill., Nov. 2, 1870, to Margaret and Daniel Weldon. She came with her parents to Eugene in 1889, and was married to Atmer Lombard in 1890. They took up a homestead in Fox Hollow the same year. Mr. Lombard retired in 1940.

Mrs. Lombard's main interests were her family, her flower garden and her church. She was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church; one of the two charter members of the River Road Women's Club, of which she was a president; a member of Evangeline Chapter 51, OES, and active in the Lane County Pioneer Assn.

Other survivors are two daughters, Nellie Mae Lombard of Alhambra, Cal., and Jennie Maude Knapp of Palo Alto, Cal., and four grandchildren.
