## OBITUARY.

### Lombard.

Robert T. Lombard, one of the best known and most respected citizens of Racine, died last night at 9 o'clock at his home, 1315 Center street, of Bright's disease, aged 59 years. The deceased was born in 1843 at Fiskdale, Mass., and for the greater part of his life resided in Racine. For many years he conducted a successful business on Fifth street, selling harness and teamsters' repairs, being a harnessmaker by trade, in the building now occupied by W. J. Kelley.

For several years past he had been engaged in the lumbering business at Midland, Mich., but returned to Racine some time ago and remained here permanently until the time of his death.

He was an active member of the Orient chapter of the Masonic lodge No. 18, and as well a member of the Knights Templar No. 7.

He is survived by a wife, two sons, Herbert and Clinton, two sisters, Mrs. Jennie Leighton and Mrs. Mary Miller, and two brothers, Elon and John Lombard. The funeral will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from his late residence and will be conducted by the Masons.
