

VETERAN TEACHER TO BE BURIED TOMORROW

Miss Jennie Lombards Death
Ends 40 Years' Service in Se-
attle Public Schools.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. tomorrow at the First Baptist Church for Miss. Jennie Lombard, whose death yesterday ended a career of more than forty years of educational work in Seattle schools. Bonney-Watson Undertaking Company will conduct the rites. Burial will be at Lake View Cemetery.

Miss Lombard was born at Turner, Me., coming west with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. R. R. Lombard, to Port Madison in June, 1868. Death came suddenly at her apartment, 1712 Summit Ave.

Surviving her are a niece, Mrs. W. J. Colkett; two nephews, W. J. Colkett, Jr., and David G. Colkett, all of Seattle, and two nephews, Burton R. and V. E. Colkett of San Francisco, Cal., and Raymond, Wash., respectively.
